Message from the school

This week we began our first assessment week to collect information on the progress of learners for end of term reports. In the Primary Years (Year 3-6) the aim is to provide learner's the opportunity to experience, age appropriate, assessments to develop test taking skills and guidance to support their learning through standardised examinations. This is built on in the Middle Years where students have the opportunity to experience, at an age appropriate level, the challenges inherent to IGCSE and the Diploma Program standardised external assessment requirements. There will be a second assessment week in Term 3 using the GL end of year tests which will be part of end of year reports.

We have added the assessment week as one of our aims, from our school strategy this year, was to provide more formalised testing and homework to meet the expectations of parents. This highlights how responsive we like to be to best meet the needs of our community and what our parents are saying.

Parents will have a chance to be part of our strategic planning later in the academic year. However, you are always welcome to share your ideas with the school as part of our parents and teachers association. Our aim is to continually work with our community to build the best school together that we can.

Developing a fluent joined handwriting style is an important skill which Year 5/6 students have been working on. When they show the ability to do this consistently, they will receive their Pen License which entitles them to use an ink or gel pen for their learning at school.
