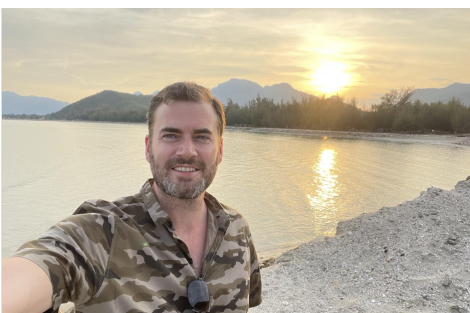
Student success: Having fun with sound
