Message from the school

We are so thankful to have our campus open again and being able to see our learners back in class! This has been another first for UDIS as we were the first day school to be approved to open and remain the only day school open in Udon Thani currently. This is testament to the layered safeguarding protocols we have worked hard to put in place including staff vaccinations, compulsory mask use, cleaning and disinfecting, class bubbles, regular screening testing, quarantines, social distancing and emergency procedures. Our procedures can limit transmission and are built on best practices locally and internationally.

Vaccinations remain the backbone of our safeguarding protocols and we have 88% of teachers with a single shot of vaccine and 81% fully vaccinated. 100% of our Early Years team are vaccinated. Vaccinations are something we have been preparing for since they were available as these are the best way to protect people within our school and our wider community. We strongly urge those within our community to get vaccinated if they have the opportunity to do so.

Lastly this week we have been running our PTA and parent reps meetings. We also have our first school board meeting this Friday. At UDIS, we work closely with our parents and community to always ensure our school is best meeting the needs of ALL stakeholders. So, we strongly urge you to get involved as we are always ready to listen to the ideas of our community.



Y7: Learners supporting each other

In Year 7 the learners have been working together to make the most of hybrid learning. In Language and Literature learners have been creating presentations on evaluating media. Through Google Meets children at home were able to present to those in class and vice versa. The children really enjoyed working together and building their learner agency skills.
