Our Journey



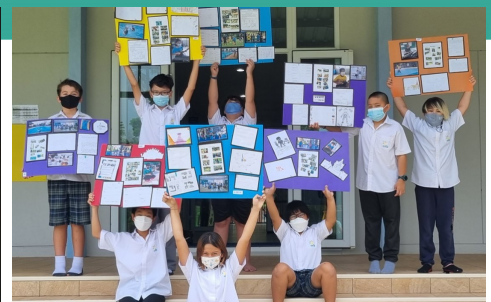
K2: Who is Yayoi Kusama?

Y5/6: Sharing the journey

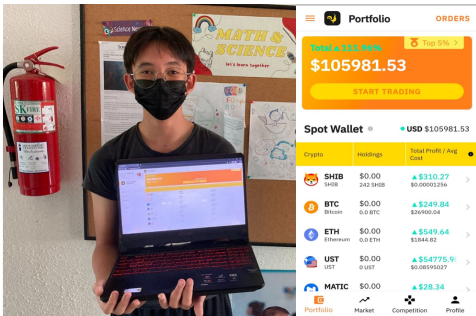
