Message from the Head of School

Year 6 has spent the past few weeks researching and learning about different body systems and how they function in both humans and animals. This past week students were able to participate in a hands-on activity to better understand how the heart pumps blood into other parts of the body.


Senior school:

Exploring chemical reactions

In Year 9 and 10, students explore methods to accelerate chemical reactions, investigating variables to increase reaction rates and to measure carbon dioxide production using a simple water displacement method. Through this process, they enhance their transfer and critical thinking skills while designing detailed lab reports.



We have begun learning about the past tense form of verbs. We looked at various examples and watched educational videos to help us remember the rules of changing the present tense to the past tense. We created our own sentences by connecting with our experiences from our summer vacation. We were able to take more risks with our writing by incorporating time expressions like 'yesterday', 'last week', this morning' and 'two hours ago'.
