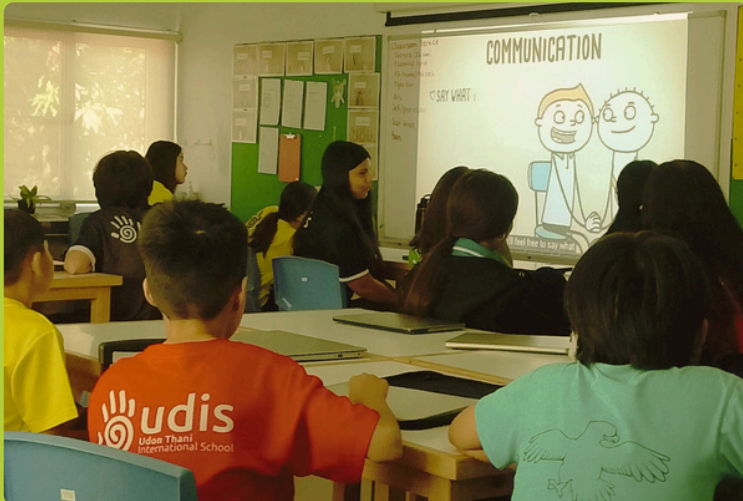


## Year 5 : Art as communication
